The Dining Room

Adjacent to the main hall is the dining room, which can seat up to 45 for a wedding breakfast it is also licensed for wedding ceremonies, this room can be used for those who prefer a small, intimate ceremony.

This room boasts high ceilings decorated with the finest Victorian cornices and wall panelling to match the Italian fireplace. The room is filled with light from the stone mullioned floor to ceiling window, allowing beautiful views down the private drive to the gardens and lake.



The Main Hall

As you walk through the balustrade stone steps and through the imposing entrance porch you enter into the large hall with its high ornate ceilings, grand stone fire place and the flowing oak staircase. You will immediately see and feel the grandeur that is Middleton Hall.

The Main Hall, which is licensed for civil ceremonies and partnerships, can be transformed to your personal preference to hold up to 92 of your guests for both ceremonies and wedding breakfasts.



The Orangery

Seat your guests on the large paved area allowing them to soak up the glorious weather whilst looking on in marvel at your unique wedding ceremony setting.
